



CASE STUDY: FARSTAD





PROJECT: TLQ FOR IMR SERVICE

Farstad, a Norwegian based vessel company, was actively bidding on a project in the Cantarell field and needed a US based supplier for its temporary vessel accommodation solution. In its search, Farstad contacted HB Rentals to see if HB could deliver the solution it needed. What HB didn't know until we got the call was that the vessel had already left port and was on its way to Mexico. With the clock ticking, HB Rentals would have to execute a temporary accommodation project flawlessly in order to meet the the needs of the client, in the little time that was available.

CHALLENGE

The unique challenge of this project was the extremely tight time window Farstad had. Not having supported Farstad in the past, HB was starting from scratch. HB Rentals would need to engineer the solution, obtain regulatory approval, install the entire complex with platforms and stairs and then reach the project site in offshore Mexico.

SOLUTION

When HB got the call, the Far Sentinel was already on the move from Norway to the Gulf of Mexico. To accelerate the process, a detailed site survey took place in Newcastle, England by an Aberdeen based HB Rentals Project Manager before the vessel sailed on to port in Louisiana, USA.

Working together with a team from Farstad, HB Rentals had the rental cost estimated and the execution plan mapped out. Our front end engineering design (FEED) report allowed us to speak to how HB would execute the custom engineering and regulatory submittals Furthermore, HB had already planned the module preparation based on the scope, module mobilization to the Port of Fourchon, and installation onto Far Sentinel

RESULTS

For the Far Sentinel project, HB was able to make schedule, delivering a complete temporary living quarters solution.
